Menopause is associated with hormonal changes that affect many organs, including the skin. As oestrogen levels decline, the skin undergoes structural changes that can impact its strength, hydration, and elasticity.

How menopause affects the skin

Oestrogen plays an important role in maintaining collagen, elastin, and skin hydration. Reduced levels may lead to:

- Accelerated collagen loss and reduced firmness
- Increased dryness and sensitivity
- Thinning of the skin and reduced elasticity
- Dullness and crepey texture

These changes are commonly noticed on the face, neck, décolletage, and hands.

Why collagen matters

Collagen provides the skin with structure and resilience. During menopause, collagen loss accelerates, contributing to skin laxity, fine lines, and reduced skin quality.
